Player Registration

STEP 1: Sign on with CFC via Signonday (Club Level Registration)

Pay the Club Fee using the payment methods available in Signonday

- Signonday offers payment options including Credit/debit card, Bank transfer, PayPal Pay in 4, ZIP, OpenPay and e-Gifts.
- Payment plans can be set up in Signonday via the available payment methods.
- FairPlay vouchers can be uploaded to Signonday and \$150.00 is automatically deducted off the Club Fees (Please note you will need to obtain your FairPlay Voucher prior to registration)

Stack Team App

2023 Registration Terms & Conditions

By Signing your child or yourself as a player for Coomera & District Soccer & Recreation Club Inc., also known as Coomera Colts Soccer Club and Coomera FC (**the Club**), you agree to all our Disclaimers, Terms and Conditions.

FEES, PAYMENTS AND ADMINISTRATION FEES

I UNDERSTAND THAT MY CHILD/CHILDREN CANNOT PLAY IF THEY ARE NOT A FINANCIAL MEMBER OF THE CLUB BY START OF SEASON.

If player is under 18 I as the parent am responsible for fees and fines that my child/children incur whilst playing for the club. If 18 or over I am responsible for fees and fines that my child/children incur whilst playing for the club.

The Club reserves the right to retain and deposits paid or deduct a \$20 administration fee as well as all federation fees from any cancellation refunds / deregistration requests after players have been made active or allocated into a team.

In signing on my child or myself as a player for **the Club** I take full responsibility for payment of fees in full to Coomera Soccer Club. To avoid any legal action against Myself / Parent / guardian and or player, payment should be paid at time of registration. If payment is not made by start of season allocated date in full, I am aware that all fees, costs associated in recoveries of money either through a collection agent or lawyers will be passed on to me for payment in full in addition to registration fees. All fines yellow and red cards to be paid in full by player / parent / guardian.

REFUND POLICY AND PROCEDURES

1. Where a player has registered and does not take part in any training activities (including pre-season training), player grading or selection processes, sanctioned matches, fees will be refunded less any Governing Body fees (if the player is registered in PlayFootball with Football Qld).
2. A refund of the Governing body fees will only be undertaken after approval from Football Qld. Refer to the Football Qld Refund of Governing Body Fees policy which can be found on the Football Qld website.
3. A request for refund will be considered where a member leaves **the Club** during the season on a case by case basis.
4. Refunds will NOT be provided for the following:
 - a. Non-refundable deposits
 - b. Cost of training kits (included in the registration fee) once issued
 - c. FQ Academy fixed costs eg. coach fees, academy training fees, on and off-field uniforms

d. Match day and referee fees levied for competition ages

5. Where a refund is granted, an administration processing fee of \$20.00 will apply.

Where a player's registration is withdrawn by **the Club** for breaches of the FFA Code of Conduct, no refund, regardless of the number of matches participated in, will be paid.

CODE OF CONDUCT PARENTS / SPECTATORS

ENCOURAGE PLAYERS TO PLAY BY THE RULES at all times. Remember that children play for their enjoyment not yours.

NEVER RIDICULE OR ABUSE ANY PLAYER. Do not yell at player mistakes.

NEVER ARGUE WITH GAME OFFICIALS. This is not acceptable behaviour at a game and not the example we want to set for our players. Accept the decisions of the referees. Ignore refereeing mistakes and teach players to do likewise. Maintain your personal dignity as an example to all young players.

SHOW RESPECT FOR ALL COACHES AND CLUB OFFICIALS. Remember that all coaches freely volunteer their time. All club positions are unpaid and that the club would not exist without our volunteers.

I WILL MAKE EVERY EFFORT TO GET MY CHILD TO EVERY TRAINING SESSION & EVERY GAME. IF I CANNOT GET MY CHILD TO ONE OF THE ABOVE, I WILL NOTIFY THE COACH AS EARLY AS POSSIBLE.

PLAYER CODE OF CONDUCT

Always PLAY BY THE RULES. Be competitive within the rules.

NEVER ARGUE WITH GAME OFFICIALS. Accept the decisions of the referees. Referees will make mistakes and so will you. Without them there would be no game. Be in control of your emotions whatever the situation.

SHOW RESPECT TO YOUR COACH. All coaches freely volunteer their time to assist players to develop their football skills. Without them there would be no team.

SHOW RESPECT TO YOUR FELLOW PLAYERS. Treat your teammates as you would have them treat you. Remember there is no I in team. Maintain your dignity in every action and words.

BE A GOOD SPORT AT ALL TIMES. Win with humility and lose with grace.
APPLAUD all good play whether it is by your team or the opposition.

I WILL MAKE EVERY EFFORT TO ATTEND EVERY TRAINING SESSION AND EVERY GAME. IF I CANNOT MAKE TRAINING OR THE GAME, I WILL NOTIFY MY COACH OR MANAGER AS EARLY AS POSSIBLE.

MEDICAL TREATMENT

I/We hereby give my/our consent for my named child who plays and trains at **the Club**. I/We confirm that this request also extends to all training & competitions in which **the Club** is involved with at various venues. In the event of an injury to the registered player needing to be attended and treated by a qualified medical practitioner or any nursing staff an ambulance will be called, and player sent to hospital. Even if Parents /guardians permission cannot be given at the time of the injury.

CORRESPONDENCE AND MEDIA

All correspondence will be sent via Stack Team App, or emails or The Club's Coomera FC | Facebook Some information will be placed on website AND OR Facebook. Coaches and Managers will contact players regarding individual team information. Player/ parent/ guardian are responsible for checking if they feel they are missing out on information. **Please keep email and mobile contacts current with the Club, Coaches and Managers.**

If you don't wish your child to appear in any media for the club please advise the Secretary and also your Coaches and Managers. We do put game photos etc on our website and Facebook pages throughout the season.

VOLUNTEERS PARENTS MUST ASSIST

All Parents of junior teams are required to volunteer for field setup and Club Official at least twice a year, for 60 min either before or after your game. Please make sure that you can fill this small requirement that enables us to keep fees down and the games running smoothly on game days.
